## HOLIDAY ADVISING HOURS

appointment over the phone, as well as a phone number to contact you at. If you are in town or prefer to travel to East Lansing from your hometown, please call ahead of time if the weather looks hazardous to be sure our office is open.

We will begin the spring semester with extended walk-in hours for the first week, which will be published closer to the start of the semester on the Dashboard appointment web site.

Keep in mind that these will be quick appointments to discuss spring scheduling changes only. All other questions should be done during an appointment prior to the start of the new semester or wait until after the open add period ends on January 11.
